A Bachelor of Arts degree and a Bachelor of Science degree are equally valued. Both offer the students who earn them the opportunity to continue their education at the master's degree level if they are so inclined. But, the two tracks do tend to hone different strengths. The coursework required for a Bachelor of Arts degree generally allows students to sharpen their oral and written communication skills. The demands of a Bachelor of Science degree include sharpening basic Communication skills as well as developing analytical skills relevant to Communication in a more in-depth manner.

Accelerated BA/MA (Master of Arts) in Communication

While the Communication BA can be completed 100% online, graduate courses taken toward the MA portion of the accelerated BA-MA option are not available 100% online.

Communication majors who are considering pursuing a master's degree (MA) in Communication can speed up the process by applying some of their undergraduate credit hours toward a master's degree. Undergraduate students interested in participating in an accelerated dual bachelors/master's degree offered through the University's Soaring Scholar Program must first meet with their academic advisor and be accepted into the program. Once accepted, students will receive an official admission letter outlining program policies and details. They will then work with their department and academic advisor to register for classes each semester, ensuring they meet the milestones and academic progress requirements of the Soaring Scholar program. Students accepted into the Accelerated BA/MA take three graduate courses (9) credit hours) as an undergraduate that apply toward both the bachelor's degree and the eventual master's degree. A Soaring Scholar student is considered an undergraduate student until their bachelor's degree is conferred. In their final undergraduate semester, they are expected to apply for admission to their respective master's program.

Accelerated BA/MA (Master of Arts) in Communication (Soaring Scholars)

Communication majors who are considering pursuing a master's degree (MA) in Communication can speed up the process by applying some of their undergraduate credit hours toward a master's degree. Undergraduate students interested in participating in an accelerated dual bachelors/master's degree offered through the University's Soaring Scholar Program must first meet with their academic advisor and be accepted into the program. Once accepted, students will receive an official admission letter outlining program policies and details. They will then work with their department and academic advisor to register for classes each semester, ensuring they meet the milestones and academic progress requirements of the Soaring Scholar program. Students accepted into the Accelerated BA/MA take three graduate courses (9 credit hours) as an undergraduate that apply toward both the bachelor's degree and the eventual master's degree. A Soaring Scholar student is considered an undergraduate student until their bachelor's degree is conferred. In their final undergraduate semester, they are expected to apply for admission to their respective master's program.

Interested students must apply for admission to the Soaring Scholars program. Admission will be based on cumulative GPA (3.25 or better after earning 45 credit hours), completion of COMM 316 with a grade of B or higher, and two letters of recommendation from Communication faculty.
