

# REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

#### **Requirements for Graduation**

All students must pass or satisfactorily complete the following courses:

## 1. All required courses in the basic full-time curriculum as set out below

#### **1L Required Classes**

- · Lawyering Skills I and II
- · Property I and II
- · Contracts I and II
- · Torts I and II
- · Criminal Law
- · Civil Procedure I

#### **2L Required Courses**

- · Constitutional Law I and II
- · Civil Procedure II

#### Required Upper Division (2L and 3L) Classes

- · Professional Responsibility
- · Perspective Course
- · Upper Division Writing Requirement Course
- · 18 credit hours of Core courses
- 6 Credit Hours of experiential learning courses, which includes 2 credit hours of live client externship or clinic courses

### 2. Additional Requirements:

- The Legal Profession Curriculum
- · Public Service Requirement
