

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

Requirements for Graduation

All students must pass or satisfactorily complete the following courses:

1. All required courses in the basic full-time curriculum as set out below

1L Required Classes

- Lawyering Skills I and II
- Property I and II
- Contracts I and II
- Torts I and II
- Criminal Law
- Civil Procedure I

2L Required Courses

- Constitutional Law I and II
- Civil Procedure II

Required Upper Division (2L and 3L) Classes

- Professional Responsibility
- Perspective Course
- Upper Division Writing Requirement Course
- 18 credit hours of Core courses
- 6 Credit Hours of experiential learning courses, which includes 2 credit hours of live client externship or clinic courses

2. Additional Requirements:

- The Legal Profession Curriculum
- Public Service Requirement
