In 1998, the University of Louisville Trover Campus at Madisonville began offering medical students from UofL the opportunity to complete the last two years of medical school in a rural community. The Trover Campus is based in Madisonville, KY and is designed to accommodate up to 12 third-year and 12 fourth-year students for their clinical rotations. Students may apply for dedicated admission to the Trover Rural Track Program by indicating their interest on UofL's Secondary Application and completing the Trover Rural Track application.
